A SURPRISE ENCOUNTER WITH JESUS

A woman from Grand Rapids, Michigan, fell asleep on the couch after her husband had gone to bed.

An intruder sneaked in through the sliding door which the couple had forgotten to lock, and crept through the house.

He entered the bedroom where the husband was sleeping and picked up the television set.

The sleeping man woke up, saw a figure standing there, and whispered, "Honey, come to bed."

The burglar panicked, put down the TV, grabbed a stack of money from the dresser, and ran out.

The thief was in for a big surprise.

The money turned out to be a stack of Christian pamphlets with a likeness of a \$20 bill on one side and an explanation of the love and forgiveness God offers to people on the other side.

Instead of the cash he expected, the intruder got the story of God's love for him.

As I read this devotion from "Our Daily Bread" several weeks ago, it reminded me of a chance encounter which ends up giving some men something valuable, but something they were not expecting.

We recently celebrated Easter, or Resurrection Sunday, and marveled at the resurrection, but the story doesn't end there.

The Bible says: And, behold, two of them went that same day to a village called Emmaus, which was from Jerusalem about threescore furlongs. (7 miles) And they talked together of all these things which had happened. And it came to pass, that, while they communed together and reasoned, Jesus himself drew near, and went with them. [Luke 24;13-15]

That is Biblical text from which we get our Emmaus Walk. Their eyes were blinded to who Jesus was, and He revealed His identity only after taking great pains to explain to them "the things concerning Himself in all the Scriptures".

I can imagine Cleopas and his friend standing in amazement; perhaps embracing in great joy, asking each other, "Were not our hearts burning within us while he talked with us on the road and opened the Scriptures to us?"

The men's Emmaus Walk starts Thursday and the women's walk in a month.

We have an opportunity to be Jesus' hands and feet in revealing the true Jesus to the pilgrims and at closing on Sunday "watching their hearts burning within them" as they share what the Emmaus journey meant to them.

Let us be in much prayer, encouragement, and participation during these upcoming Emmaus Walks.
