Massillon Baptist College dormitory—Dr. W. Jay Dolvin Hall—has separate floors for men and ladies. Each dorm room has built-in wardrobes with storage space, and study tables with chairs. These rooms are spacious enough to accommodate four people. Each room has bunk beds. The rooms are electrically heated, with separate controls in each room for comfort. The ladies have sinks and counters in each room.

Each floor has shower and lavatory facilities. Washers and dryers are provided free of charge. A dormitory supervisor's apartment is also located in the building to assure safety, fellowship, and godly counseling.

The dormitories are within easy walking distance of all classrooms, so that a car is not necessary. However, for those who have automobiles, a lighted parking lot is located adjacent to the building. Students must have proof of insurance on file in the college office before permission to drive or park on the campus may be granted. For security purposes, parking tags will be issued to those students with automobiles.

Please note the following:

- 1. A room retainer fee of \$25.00 must accompany each dormitory reservation form. This fee is non-refundable and remains valid only one week after the date of registration and orientation nearest to the date reservation is received.
- 2. The cost of room and board during the regular school year (mid-Aug. through mid-May) is \$2,700 (\$1,350 per semester)—payable as follows: August 16-31 and May 1-15, at \$150.00; September through April, at \$300.00. Hot lunches are available at the cafeteria Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Sack lunches are available upon request. These requests should be made at the beginning of lunch, to be picked up at the end of lunch.
- 3. Stoves, refrigerators and microwaves are provided for student use. However, a student may have a small room refrigerator in his/her room at the extra cost of \$5.00 a month.
- 4. All dormitory reservations should be received by the college office no later than ten (10) days prior to the semester registration and orientation dates.
- 5. All prospective dormitory occupants must be officially accepted as students of Massillon Baptist College before they will be permitted to move on campus.
- 6. Plan your arrival so that you can register and receive keys from the college office. Office hours are 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. If you must arrive after office hours, please notify the college office ahead of time to make arrangements Phone: 330-830-5902; Fax: 330-830-5980.
- 7. Students over the age of 25 cannot live in the dorm.
- 8. No student who has been married (whether separated, divorced, annulled, or widowed) may live in the dorm.
