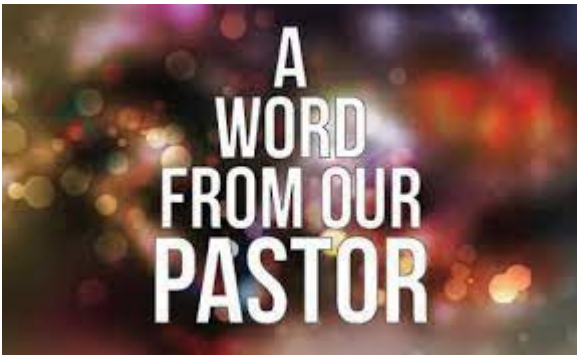
Women's Choir

The Revelation of God

In theology we talk about two main ways that God has revealed himself to people. There is general revelation. This is typically understood as God revealing himself through creation, that which He has made. As we look at every aspect of creation from the very small to the very large, we as Christ followers find it hard to believe that people believe that this all happened by chance, without an intelligent designer who is God. The second area of revelation is the Bible. God reveals his attributes and his character on every page of the Bible from beginning to end. One of the favorite Psalms of many is Psalm 19. This Psalm addresses the revelation of God.

¹ The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of his hands.

² Day after day they pour forth speech; night after night they display knowledge.

³ There is no speech or language where their voice is not heard.

⁴ Their voice goes out into all the earth, their words to the ends of the world. In the heavens he has pitched a tent for the sun,

⁵ which is like a bridegroom coming forth from his pavilion, like a champion rejoicing to run his course.

⁶ It rises at one end of the heavens and makes its circuit to the other; nothing is hidden from its heat.

⁷ The law of the LORD is perfect, reviving the soul. The statutes of the LORD are trustworthy, making wise the simple.

⁸ The precepts of the LORD are right, giving joy to the heart. The commands of the LORD are radiant, giving light to the eyes.

⁹ The fear of the LORD is pure, enduring forever. The ordinances of the LORD are sure and altogether righteous.

¹⁰ They are more precious than gold, than much pure gold; they are sweeter than honey, than honey from the comb.

I encourage you to read the whole Psalm. But let us all praise God for the ways he has made himself known to us. He is not a hidden, unknowing God. But he is a God who we can know intimately.
