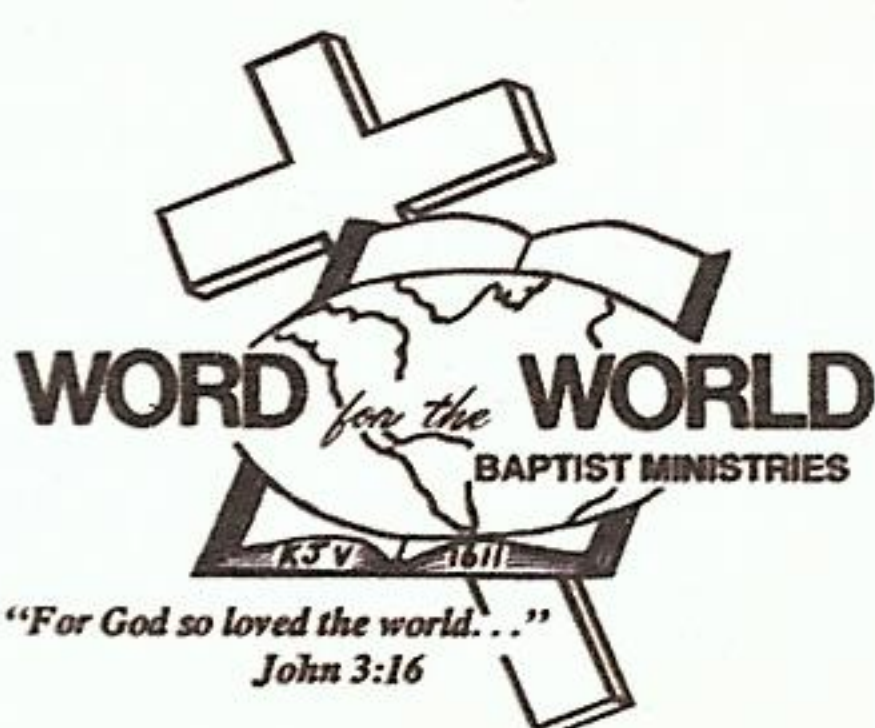

Dear Friends and Family,

Greetings in the name of our Blessed Lord, Jesus Christ! The Lord has blessed us and kept us busy these last two months with several meetings in great churches. We have had five more churches take us on for support which brings our support level to 89%! As a result of this blessing, we have some very exciting news in this letter!

As we have been growing much closer to our support goal, I have been in much prayer about when to leave for Ireland. In June, we met up with the Craig Ledbetter family, the family we will be working with in Ireland, at the Word for the World Candidate School. This meeting was most profitable in preparing us for the actual move to Ireland and the settling in. We were able to work out the details and get answers to many of our questions.

In the beginning of July, we met with our pastor, Dr. Jon Jenkins, and together decided that it was time to set a target date to leave for the field. After much counsel from both Dr. Jenkins and Bro. Ledbetter, we chose September 13th as our target date for departure! Our Commissioning Service will be at our home church, Grace Baptist Church, on September 9th!

Choosing our target date has been an exciting time for us, but also a nervous one. When we started full-time deputation, leaving for Ireland seemed a distant dream. Now, the time has come – our leaving for Ireland is fast becoming a reality. God has been preparing us for this day, and we believe that we are ready to begin this next chapter in our lives.

We have a few prayer requests. The first request is for the remaining 11% of our support so that we will be fully supported in Ireland. The second is for wisdom in preparing everything for our departure. The next two months will involve many details and lots of packing. Lastly, we are praying that our finances will be enough for our start-up fund by the time we leave for Ireland and that everything will go smoothly with immigration once we arrive.

We are so thankful for your faithful prayers and support! We pray the Lord blesses you abundantly for your labor of love to us.
