The village of Ocomupe has a great church! The one thing it lacks is water. Most people must go to water sources that require a lot of walking to fill buckets for their daily use. One of our supporting churches, Pleasantview Baptist Church in Texas, along with Manna Water for Life came down and spent a week drilling and constructing a new water well for the church. This well will provide water to the surrounding communities as a form of outreach! During the drilling process, we were told by professionals that we were drilling in a dry zone and shouldn't expect more than a few gallons per minute of production. These same professionals began constructing a well twice as deep about a mile away. In the end, the professional's well was dry, but the church's well was producing 10 gallons per minute!

The team from Texas had the opportunity to take time to visit the local public school in the village as well as pass out water filters. Using these tools we shared the Gospel in every home we visited. Nine souls accepted Christ as their personal Savior!
